THE APPELLATION

The AOC Palette is the smallest and the oldest appellation of Provence. It was born in 1948 and it counts only 42 hectares. The appellation is composed by various Provençal grapes which are respected and preserved. The harvests are manual. This micro-appellation is at the gates of Aix-en-Provence.

Its soil is made of « Calcaire de Langesse » which is directly derived from the Sainte-Victoire mountain massif.

VINIFICATION

Grapes are harvested by hand and are then destemmed and sorted out. This wine is produced by static draining of our red wine vats and is aged in barrels for 8 months.

TASTING NOTE

Light salmon color highlighted by silver shimmer. Rich aromatic profile with fresh fruits, mint and hint of licorice. The mouth is rich and powerful with sweet balance. The final is smooth on peach peel aromas marked by a coffee finish.

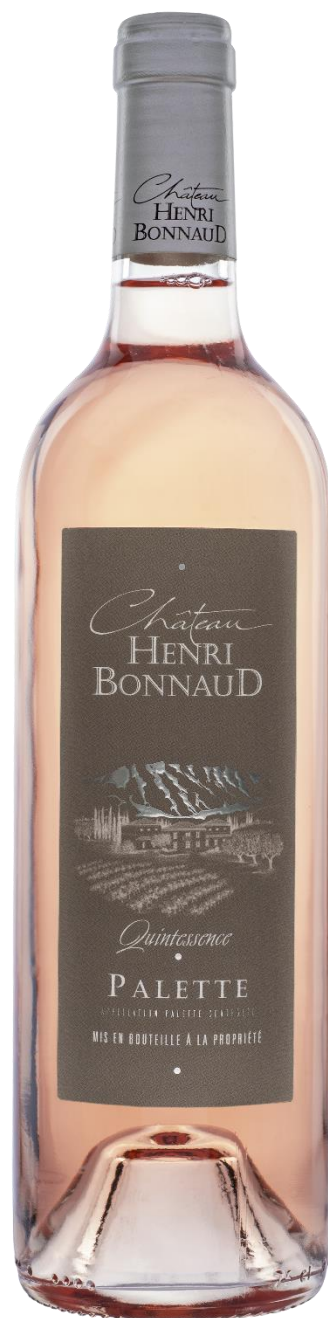
